ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS OPPORTUNITIES

Family Matters: The focus of this class is exploring life issues relating to families. Families from those of one through those who have extended intergenerational families will find this class relevant to their daily lives and challenges. This class utilizes the same curriculum as the children's and youth classes, *Faith Weaver*. Philip West is the facilitator and the class meets in Ephesus.

Present Word: During the winter quarter this group is studying the Gospel of Matthew, with emphasis on Christ as the fulfillment of the Old Testament promises and prophecies. The purpose of this study is to explore the Bible in context, with the ultimate goal of increasing our understanding of God's revelation of himself to the world through the life and teachings of Jesus. Meets in Galatia.

Life Lessons: The class is studying topics from the book titled *When God Whispers Your Name* by Max Lucado, a well known Christian writer and minister at Oak Hills Church in San Antonio, Texas.

Issues: This class is studying the Efrd Bible Series on the Gospel of Mark. This will be an on-going series as it has 17 parts. This class is taught by Tom Cook and Tommy Mathews.
