GUEST PREACHER – Please give a warm welcome this morning to Rev. Dr. James Bradley Miller. Dr. Miller is an honorably retired ordained minister in the Presbyterian Church (USA) with an MDiv from Union Theological Seminary in Virginia and a Ph.D. from Marquette University. He has served as an ecumenical campus minister at Michigan Technological University, the University of Pittsburgh, Carnegie Mellon University and Chatham College. Immediately following seminary, Jim worked for five years in the School of Engineering at North Carolina State University. From 1996-2009 he served as the Senior Program Associate for the Program of Dialogue on Science, Ethics, and Religion of the American Association for the Advancement of Science (AAAS). He is the editor or co-editor of five books most recently *The Evolution Dialogues* (2006). Jim has served as an elected officer and volunteer staff for the Presbyterian Association on Science, Technology and the Christian Faith since its establishment in 1992 and is currently its general missionary.

ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL CLASS OPPORTUNITIES

Family Matters: The focus of this class is exploring life issues relating to families. Families from one to those who have extended intergenerational families will find this class relevant to their daily lives and challenges. This class utilizes the same curriculum as the children's and youth classes, *Faith Weaver*. Philip West is the facilitator and the class meets in Ephesus.

Present Word: During the winter quarter this group is studying the Gospel of Matthew, with emphasis on Christ as the fulfillment of the Old Testament promises and prophesies. The purpose of this study is to explore the Bible in context, with the ultimate goal of increasing our understanding of God's revelation of himself to the world through the life and teachings of Jesus. Meets in Galatia.

Life Lessons: The focus of this class is based on our church's emphasis on the 2010 "Year of Living Prayerfully." The class is using the books "*Longing to Pray*" and "*50 Ways to Pray*" as part of our curriculum. "*Longing to Pray*" teaches us to talk (pray) with God through the Psalms and to nurture our friendship with God through prayer. We will use the book "*50 ways to Pray*" to learn new and active ways we can pray.

Issues: This class is studying the Efir Bible Series on the Gospel of Mark. This will be an on-going series as it has 17 parts. This class is taught by Tom Cook and Tommy Mathews.
